HANG SENG INDEXES ANNOUNCES INDEX REVIEW RESULTS

Hang Seng Indexes Company Limited (“Hang Seng Indexes”) today announced the results of its review of the Hang Seng Family of Indexes for the quarter ended 30 June 2010. All changes will take effect on 6 September 2010 (Monday).

F. Eligibility of Foreign Companies

On 4 June 2010, Hang Seng Indexes announced an interim policy which states that companies classified as 'Foreign Companies' by Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited will not be included in the constituent stock universes for the indexes in the Hang Seng Family of Indexes.

As a part of its study on the eligibility of Foreign Companies, Hang Seng Indexes will collect opinions on this issue from market participants through a survey, which is expected to complete in the fourth quarter of this year. A further notice will be issued upon completion of the study.

The review will normally be completed within eight weeks after each calendar quarter-end.
